Last year a few of our members went along and took some of the children out in their cars on an informal drive around the airfield which was very rewarding. **3rd**<sup>d</sup> **September** club night – I have arranged a speaker from The Motor Garage near Salisbury.

**Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> October** – Malcolm Sykes has kindly agreed to organise a day trip out with lunch. The starting point will be Malcolm and Jan's house in Fleet. If you are interested please let Malcolm know. There will be more details nearer the time.

The Mill at Sonning, 30<sup>th</sup> November 2019 – tickets are almost sold out but I am sure if anyone would still like to go we will be able to obtain some more tickets even if it means we can't all sit together. The show this year is "Singing in the Rain" and the cost is £62.50 per ticket and includes dinner before the show.

Christmas dinner, Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2019 –don't forget to book for our Christmas dinner at the Norton Park Hotel again. The cost for this year will be £24.00 per head for a three course dinner and a Champagne reception all in the Wonston Room. This is a heavily discounted price which we negotiated with their management in view of the problems we had last year. Our numbers have increased to 46 people attending which is great news but it would still be good to fill the room with 50 members as last year so please do not be put off by the problems we had last year and come and make it a great success to end the year. If you are interested please let me have a deposit of £6 per head. The hotel is also holding rooms for us at a special rate of £85.00 per room, for bed and breakfast, so if you intend to stay at the hotel don't forget to book your room with central reservations and let them know you are with the Jaguar Drivers Club. This should be a very good evening and this year the Club will provide the wine on the tables.

#### **2020 tours**

We have now finalised the details for our **European tour** which is being organised by Scenic and Continental Car Tours. The dates are **18**<sup>th</sup>-**26**<sup>th</sup> **May 2020** for an 8 night tour of the Black Forest area of Germany and the Ardennes area of Belgium with a final night in Ypres. For those who do not wish to participate in the 8 night tour we are offering an alternative 4 night tour from **22**<sup>nd</sup>-**26**<sup>th</sup> **May** to just the Ardennes area of Belgium with a final night in Ypres. The cost of the 8 night tour is £1,099.00 per person and the 4 night tour is £599.00 per person. This includes half board accommodation in all the hotels except the one in Ypres where dinner is not included. You should already have received full details from me. A number of members indicated that they would be interested in these tours but to date have not booked direct with Scenic Cars. It is imperative that you do so no later than 15<sup>th</sup> June 2019 to secure your place and let me know please when you have done so.

We have also now finalised the details of a tour to the **Lake District** which will take place from **24**<sup>th</sup>-**28**<sup>th</sup> **September 2020** (4 nights) when we will be staying at the Castle Inn at Lake Bassenthwaite, near Keswick (<a href="www.castleinncumbria.co.uk">www.castleinncumbria.co.uk</a>). The cost of this tour will be £499.00 per person for half board accommodation and details of how to book this tour will be sent out during week beginning 17<sup>th</sup> June 2019. In the meantime if you are interested in joining this tour, please let me know as soon as possible.

Don't forget our next Club night is on 2<sup>nd</sup> July is at the Millhouse at North Warnborough.
